## ACHIEVEMENT SCHOLARSHIP

Thank you for showing an interest in the Johnson City Area Home Builders Association and Home Builders Association of Tennessee's scholarship program. For scholarship consideration:

1. Applicants must be at least a high school senior to be considered for a scholarship.
2. The student must be seeking post-secondary education at a trade school, community college, or a four-year program in the State of Tennessee and should be currently residing in Carter, Johnson, Unicoi or Washington Counties.
3. Applicant must be furthering their education in a Building Industry Related Curriculum (examples):
  - Construction management
  - Architect
  - Interior design
  - Engineering
  - Draftsperson
  - Surveyor
  - Plumber
  - Electrician
4. The JCAHBA scholarship is awarded on a one-time basis and is not renewable.
5. The number of scholarships and awarded value/s will be determined annually by JCAHBA.
6. Scholarship awards will be presented to recipient(s) in the form of a certificate. A check redeemable to the financial office of the chosen school/college in the State of Tennessee will be issued once proof of acceptance has been received.
7. Any incomplete applications are automatically disqualified for consideration.
8. Any questions regarding eligibility, applications, or requirements should be addressed to Johnson City Area Home Builders Association Executive Director.

Applying for the scholarship is easy:

9. Complete and Sign the application
10. Inform your Guidance Counselor that you are applying for this scholarship
11. Include the following items with your application:
  - Proof of Admissions Application or current transcript from college, university, junior college or technical/vocational school
  - Current proof of GPA with school record showing courses, grades and academic summary.
  - Letter of recommendation from your High School Guidance Counselor or Department Instructor. Letter must include the person's name, address and telephone number.
  - An essay, no longer than one page in length, as to how you will use your studies in a construction-related field (college expectations and career goals). Make sure to address your major in the essay.

Disbursement of funds for this scholarship will be in May of the year awarded. The check will be made payable to the school the applicant will attend.

Application Deadline is January 15th.
